CCP every year, which are generally open for a period of 7 to 8 weeks.

Position Description:

Installation volunteers work with CCP Curators, Front of House Manager, exhibiting artists and external contractors to install and de-install CCP's exhibition program by undertaking physical work and providing administrative support from time to time.

Principle Duties:

- Patching walls
- Painting
- Assisting in the handling of artwork
- Assisting in the installation or hanging of artwork
- Cleaning
- Provide administrative support from time to time (e.g. answering phones, assisting with condition reporting)

As CCP evolves to meet the changing needs of its strategic objectives, so will the roles required of its volunteers. Volunteers should be aware that this document is not intended to represent the full scope of the role.
