

Key Selection Criteria

The CCP General Manager is expected to have the following competencies:

- Substantial experience in the Arts or arts/design-aligned industries, and understanding of the not-for-profit sectors.
- Experience in applying for and securing operational and project funding from government and philanthropic grants programs, and successfully reporting outcomes to acquit.
- Outstanding capabilities in leading a range of organisational functions while maintaining a values based culture at all times.
- Strong financial acumen, with demonstrable success and significant experience in dynamic workplaces of leading the development and maintaining oversight of organisational budgets.
- High level commercial understanding and notable experience in developing and maintaining beneficial commercial partnerships.
- An understanding of governance, risk and compliance management, and the ability to work effectively with a Board.
- High level networking and influencing skills with a range of stakeholders including government departments, peak bodies, business, arts and community service organisations.
- Excellent people skills with a collaborative style, and an ability to support and enhance staff and volunteer capabilities, engagement, and commitment.
- Exposure to robust strategic planning methodologies, both in concept and implementation, ensuring the processes and benefits can be fully embedded within the organisation.
- Critical thinking agility, demonstrated thought leadership and involvement in organisational transformation.
- A tertiary or post graduate qualification in arts management, or business management are desirable.
